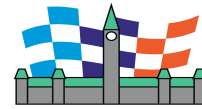


## BMW Car Club of Ottawa / Patrron Chapter BMW CCA A Day at a Driving School

### Before the event:

Read the Participant's Information Package  
Technical Inspection for your car (2 to 3 weeks before the event)  
Check the weather before you go to the event

### You need:

A helmet SA 2005, M-2005 or SA 2010, M2010 Snell certified in good condition.  
A completed and signed Technical inspection form.  
Drivers License, Car Insurance slip. Car Ownwership / title  
Wear appropriate attire (long cotton pants, closed toe shoes, cotton shirts)  
Bring snacks, a cooler with lots of non-alcoholic beverages and water.  
Bring a tarpaulin to protect your belongings from the weather.

### On the morning of the first day at the track ...

The track gates open at 7:00 A.M. **DON'T BE LATE!**

Sign a track waiver.

Find a place to park in the main paddock area.

Empty out your car of all loose items.

Registration starts at 7:15 A.M. **DON'T BE LATE!**

Get your car numbers, schedule, Instructor / student pairing information.

Hand in / Sign a club waiver.

Put your numbers on the car.

Track Sound Level Check. Drive your car to the sound test area

Too loud? No track time. No refunds

Track Tech Check (quick look at the car, check your helmet) after the sound test

Hand Technical Inspection form to the inspectors.

No form. No track time. No refunds.

Instructors meeting at 8:15 A.M. (time may change check your schedule)

Drivers meeting at at 8:30 A.M. (time may change check your schedule)

### Check your schedule!

**Be on time at the correct place** in the classroom or lined up in pit lane ready to drive.

Driving sessions usually start at 9:00 A.M.

Classroom sessions usually start at 9:00 A.M. The Novice run group normally has the first classroom session.

Students must attend class. No class time. No track time

Lunch – Depending on the schedule – Usually 1 hour around mid-day.

Afternoon: driving sessions and classroom sessions to the end of the day.

Students and event workers can ask instructors for rides during the Instructor Run Group sessions. Don't be shy Ask for a ride! You can learn a lot!
